STC H1N1 Immunization Registry Summit

STC hosted an **H1N1 Summit** to bring together front line workers and key organizations to share lessons learned during the global H1N1 outbreak. The first such initiative sponsored by a private U.S. company, this best practices summit provided the opportunity for participants to share with peers programmatic and technical lessons learned during the current H1N1 event, focusing on the use of statewide immunization registry systems.

Each attendee of the meeting, which included representatives from the state health departments of seven states and from the CDC, ASTHO, AIRA, and PHDSC, indicated they had received significant value from the meeting. Successful outcomes included:

- Identification of information gaps and strengths.
- Documentation of the use of the immunization registries during the H1N1 event.
- Definition of future enhancements to improve the use of the registries and to support future preparedness through meaningful use of the registry systems.
