

Child Care Module



Advancing Public Health Outcomes Through Information Technology

STC's Child Care Module is a web-based application that integrates directly with a state-wide Immunization Information System (IIS). The purpose of the Child Care Module is to provide child care providers with access to the IIS and to allow them to create facility reports and manage immunization coverage. Child Care providers are mandated by law to verify immunization coverage for children. Immunization records are often reviewed during health inspections and licensure visits by city and/or state representatives.

The Child Care Module features an abbreviated demographic screen where users can view demographic data and access to a child's full immunization history contained in the IIS. Child Care providers may enter new children into the IIS and add historical immunization data. Immunizations entered by child care users are considered unverified and marked with a special indicator. When looking at the IIS, a medical provider may validate and 'verify' the shot through the IIS and remove the indicator from the vaccination.

Child care users and children are associated with a child care facility which is the basis for tracking, follow up and reporting. Users with a role of District or State Coordinator will have the ability to run reports for all facilities within their respective jurisdiction(s).

Available reports include:

- ➔ Action Report—Provides follow up actions for children not in compliance with state mandates.
- ➔ Patient Detail—Displays a line listing of all children in a facility and an abbreviated view of the vaccination history.
- ➔ Child Care Inspection Report—Lists all child cares that have been inspected in the past 90 days, and those that are coming due for an annual review.
- ➔ Jurisdictional Quarterly Report—Quick view of each child in a facility and whether they are up to date, and if not, what vaccinations are currently due.
- ➔ Annual Health Inspection Survey—Detailed report for use in completing the Annual CDC Report.
